# STATE ROAD 534

## PHASE 1: FROM SR 417 TO NARCOOSSEE RD

FALL 2025

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX) is finalizing design of Phase 1 for State Road 534. Phase 1 is a 5-mile section from SR 417 near Boggy Creek Road to Narcoossee Road and it is part of the SR 534 expressway. The entire SR 534 project is a 14-mile regional transportation network that will support the current and projected transportation needs in Southeast Orange and Northeast Osceola counties.

Once the 14-mile expressway is complete, it would help relieve congestion on local roadways, support evacuation and emergency response, and enhance regional connectivity with an expressway. SR 534 will be built in three separate phases.

The design of Phase 1 is expected to be completed by early 2026, with construction anticipated to start in mid-2027 and completed by 2032.

### PROJECT MAP



The Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX) is an independent agency of the State of Florida that operates and maintains a regional network of expressways for 3.5 million residents of Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties and more than 80 million annual visitors to Central Florida. CFX's 125-centerline mile, user-funded system includes 73 interchanges, 14 mainline toll plazas, 5 mainline gantries, 76 ramp toll facilities (includes six ramp gantries) and 365 bridges. On average, more than 1.6 million toll transactions are recorded daily, all of them electronically. CFX operates E-PASS, the first electronic toll collection system in Florida, with more than one million E-PASS accounts. For more information, visit [CFXway.com](http://CFXway.com).

OCX approves Project Environmental Impact Report (PEIR).

2018

CFX completes CF&M study and begins Re-Evaluation study.

2019

Public expresses 61% support for project preferred alternative. CFX board approves.

2023

Design begins for SR 534.
